

Big, broad golf holes with subtle challenges are built into the natural terrain alongside incomparable lake and Rocky Mountain views. Voted #3 Best New Private Course in the U.S. by Golf Digest, the course is both challenging and playable for TPC Colorado Members, professional golfers and TPC guests. Featuring the longest hole in the state and on the Korn Ferry Tour, our 773-yard 13th hole is not only intimidating because of its length, but also because of "Hell Bunker" inspired by the 14th hole at The Old Course in St. Andrews, Scotland. It's also the namesake of our Clubhouse restaurant, 773 Prime.

These are only a few of the reasons why we're committed to protecting this land and those who thrive in it.




acres of lands within the Heron Lakes community were donated to the Town of Berthoud for permanent open space and recreation.
